



## **Terms & Conditions**

### **1. Definitions**

“Photographer” refers to Anthony Sajdler.

“Client” refers to the person or organisation commissioning the photography.

“Images” refers to all photographic material supplied by the Photographer, including digital files.

### **2. Booking Confirmation**

A booking is confirmed once the Client accepts the quotation in writing (including email confirmation). The agreed date and time will then be reserved for the Client.

### **3. Fees and Payment**

Fees will be as outlined in the quotation or estimate.

Invoices are payable within **30 days** unless otherwise agreed.

The Photographer reserves the right to charge interest on overdue invoices in accordance with the **Late Payment of Commercial Debts (Interest) Act 1998**.

### **4. Copyright and Usage**

Copyright in all images remains with the Photographer unless otherwise agreed in writing.

Upon full payment, the Client is granted a **licence to use the images** for their organisation’s marketing, website, press and promotional purposes.

Images may not be sold, licensed to third parties or used for resale without written permission from the Photographer.

The Photographer retains the right to use images for portfolio, website and promotional purposes unless otherwise agreed.

### **5. Delivery**

Images will be professionally edited and delivered via an online gallery or secure download.

Delivery timelines will be agreed in advance and typically range from **3–7 working days**, depending on the nature of the assignment.

### **6. Cancellation and Postponement**

If a confirmed booking is cancelled or postponed with **less than 48 hours notice**, the Photographer reserves the right to charge a cancellation fee.

Where possible, bookings may be rescheduled to an alternative mutually agreed date.



## **7. Client Responsibilities**

The Client is responsible for ensuring access to locations, obtaining any necessary permissions, and providing accurate information regarding the brief and schedule.

The Photographer will not be held responsible for missed images where restrictions or changes occur outside their control.

## **8. Liability**

While every effort is made to produce and deliver images of the highest standard, the Photographer's liability is limited to the value of the contracted services.

The Photographer will not be liable for circumstances beyond their control, including venue restrictions, weather, or unforeseen events.

## **9. Force Majeure**

Neither party shall be liable for failure to perform obligations where such failure is due to events beyond their reasonable control, including illness, accidents, natural disasters or other unforeseen circumstances.

## **10. Confidentiality**

The Photographer will treat any information, materials or documentation provided by the Client in connection with the assignment as confidential and will not disclose such information to third parties unless required to fulfil the photographic commission or where required by law.
